Pursuant to U.S.C. § 3006A(e)(2), prior approval is required for investigative, expert, and other services if the total cost of those services exceeds \$800. CJA representations in this District routinely require the use of the services of investigators and interpreters, at a cost in excess of \$800. In order to avoid the necessity of CJA defense counsel having to expend the time to apply to exceed the \$800 maximum, the Court hereby authorizes CJA defense counsel to use the services of investigators, interpreters, paralegals, psychologists, and litigation support, up to the case compensation maximums set by the CJA Guidelines, Volume 7A, § 310.20.10(A), currently \$2,500, for each service provider type, without further order of the Court.

CJA defense counsel and service providers shall otherwise comply with U.S.C. § 3006A(e)(2).
