**NOTICE OF INCREASE IN ALLOWABLE PDF FILE SIZE
FOR E-FILING WITHIN CM/ECF**

Effective immediately, the District of Oregon has increased the PDF (Portable Document Format) file size limit for single documents uploaded electronically into the CM/ECF system from 1.5 megabytes (1.5 MB) to 5 megabytes (5 MB).
