### Accrual of PACER Charges

On March 1, 2004, the US District Court for the District of Oregon will migrate all civil and criminal case data to Version 1 of the national release of the CM/ECF (Case Management / Electronic Case File) software. At that time, PACER charges for the retrieval of case data via the CM/ECF system will begin to accrue.

The United States Congress has given the Judicial Conference of the United States, the judicial governing body of the US Federal Courts, authority to impose user fees for electronic access to case information. These fees are calculated and billed from the PACER (Public Access to Court Electronic Records) Service Center. Users are invited to contact the PACER Service Center to establish an account:

There is no cost for registering with PACER. However, the Judicial Conference has set a fee of seven cents per page (which includes all case documents, docket sheets and case specific reports) for querying, viewing or downloading electronic case information via the Internet. There is a per-document fee cap of \$2.10 (30 pages) with the exception of transcripts of federal court proceedings.
