

CM/ECF REGISTRATION

On March 1, 2004 the U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon will migrate all case data to Version 1 (V1) of the national release of the CM/ECF software. This new version will include a criminal case application.

- **CM/ECF Registration:** Attorneys practicing in the U.S. District Court - Oregon who have not registered to receive e-mail notifications from the Case Management / Electronic Case Filing (CM/ECF) system are urged to do so.

Except for good cause shown by letter to the Clerk indicating a lack of computer technology to access the Internet, attorneys admitted to practice pursuant to LR 83 are required to complete and mail to the clerk's office, the CM/ECF Attorney Registration form found at www.ord.uscourts.gov/ecf. (See LR 100.2)

- **PACER Account:** A PACER (Public Access to Court Electronic Records) account is required to view documents and docket sheets on line. If your firm or office does not already have a PACER account, please contact the PACER Service Center at:
