
Standing Order 2022-6

Considering the current assessment of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) that COVID-19 transmission is low in the counties that house divisional offices for U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon, Standing Order 2022-2, which set forth mask and entry requirements, is vacated.

Judges retain the discretion to require individuals to wear a mask in courtrooms and adjacent areas, and during grand jury empanelment proceedings.

Otherwise, individuals visiting the federal district courthouses in Oregon are advised to review the CDC's guidance regarding reducing COVID-19 risk and observe the recommendations that apply to them.
