**ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following clerical corrections are to be made to the Local Rules of Civil Procedure adopted by this Court effective January 1, 2011:

1. LR 16-4(k) to correct the first citation reference of 18 U.S.C. §144 to be 28 U.S.C. §144 as follows:

(k) Disqualification of Mediators

Any person selected as a mediator may be disqualified for bias or prejudice as provided in ~~18~~ 28 U.S.C. §144 and shall be disqualified in any case in which such action would be required of a justice, judge, or Magistrate Judge governed by 28 U.S.C. §455.

2. LR 15-1(c) to correct the second sentence of that paragraph as follows:

(c) Amended Document Requirements

An amended or supplemental pleading must reproduce the entire pleading and may not incorporate any part of the prior pleading by reference. In addition, any party moving for leave to file an amended or supplemental pleading must describe the proposed changes.

3. LR 7.1-1 to correct the spelling of owners from oners as follows:

LR 7.1-1 Disclosure Statement

In diversity actions, any party that is a limited liability corporation (L.L.C.), a limited liability partnership (L.L.P.), or a partnership must, in the disclosure statement required by Fed. R. Civ. P. 7.1, list those states from which the owners/members/partners of the L.L.C., L.L.P., or partnership are citizens. If any owner/member/partner of the L.L.C.,

L.L.P., or partnership is another L.L.C., L.L.P., or partnership, then the disclosure statement must also list those states from which the ~~eners~~ owners/members/partners of the L.L.C., L.L.P., or partnership are citizens.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that these corrections are to be noted in the Amendment
