IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, in accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §2071(b), the following amendments are made to the Local Rules of Civil Procedure adopted by this Court, effective March 1, 2012:

Beginning September 10, 2012, LR 100-5(a) is amended to require Registered Users (as described in LR 1-5(k)) to file electronically, rather than file in hard copy/paper, documents authorized for filing under seal pursuant to an existing protective order in a civil case. The CM/ECF User Manual available on the Court's website describes the manner and process for electronically filing such documents.

The requirement to provide a paper judge's copy for electronically filed documents pursuant to LR 100-7 remains unchanged.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that LR 3-7 is amended to allow remote, electronic access to the documents filed in a manner that is consistent with the terms of the protective order, or as otherwise ordered by the Court.
