- j. Trial Briefs.

4. Impeachment Exhibits.

Impeachment exhibits will be marked, sealed, and delivered only to the Court. Each party shall separately identify exhibits the party expects to offer and those the party may offer if the need arises. Impeachment exhibits will be delivered to the Court prior to the pretrial conference in conjunction with the materials listed in section 3.
