**ORDER**

In light of operational limitations at the Social Security Administration Office of General Counsel in Seattle, Washington, during the COVID-19 outbreak, the United States District Court for the District of Oregon suspends the requirements of Local Rule 5-2(e) and Standing Order 2016-12 that the United States Attorney provide to the presiding judge and to plaintiff's counsel a text-searchable CD-ROM of the Administrative Record in Social Security disability cases arising under 42 U.S.C. §§ 405(g) and 1383(c). This Standing Order applies to any such cases in which an answer was due on or after March 16, 2020, and remains in effect until vacated or amended.
