The Attorney General's Office for the State of Oregon has agreed to receive, electronically, service of petitions for Writs of Habeas Corpus filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2254. Service is effected through a Notice of Electronic Filing ("NEF") generated when the first scheduling order is docketed in the Case Management/Electronic Case Filing System ("CM/ECF"). Upon receipt of the NEF, petition, and scheduling order, the Attorney General's Office will file an Acknowledgment of Service with the Clerk of the Court.

For notification purposes only, a designated Assistant Attorney General will be added to the docket by the Clerk as attorney of record for the State of Oregon. Adding the Assistant Attorney General's name to the docket does not constitute an appearance by the state on behalf of the respondent. The Attorney General's Office for the State of Oregon may withdraw its consent to service through NEF at any time with 30 days' notice to the Court.
